

BALLARATS SPRINGTIME BASK

On the Saturday we will travel through some beautiful country side known as The BRISBANE RANGES to a lunch destination. After that we will ride to a small town where you can have a coffee, a smoke, a walk around or just stand and talk, the choice will be yours, and then back to Ballarat, a total distance for the day of 200-220Kms (as not yet completely mapped out in total)

On the Saturday night we will have a hotel booked for those who would like to come along and have an evening meal together with us; it will be a bistro type venue with a reasonable priced menu

Sunday will be a shorter ride, through the Staffordshire Reef which is along some lovely timbered, winding country roads. Once again there will be a lunch stop for those who would like a bite to eat, this won't be far from Ballarat and we will back to the finish by 1.30 or there abouts so you can be on your way home at a reasonable time, total approx 100Km's

The rally will be self marshaling and self catering (all meals at your expense) there will be an entry fee of \$5.00 payable on the day (one day or both) to cover costs such as backup trailer etc.

We have kept the distance down and also the speed will be at a pace to suit classic bikes, should you turn up on a modern you are most welcome, but please remember this is a CLASSIC RALLY
