All motorcycles must be roadworthy and be either on limited registration or full road registration and all riders must be the holder of a current motorcycle rider's licence.

Any entrant riding in a manner deemed by the organisers not to be in the spirit of the event such as but not exclusively unsafe overtaking, undertaking, wheel-stands and excessive speed will be excluded from further participation in the event.

I agree to wear a fully approved helmet at all times whilst riding in the event.

I agree to abide by the regulations of the event and all the instructions of the Club Committee and Marshals, and all road and traffic laws including speed limits, by-laws and regulations and to show due courtesy to all users of the roads.
